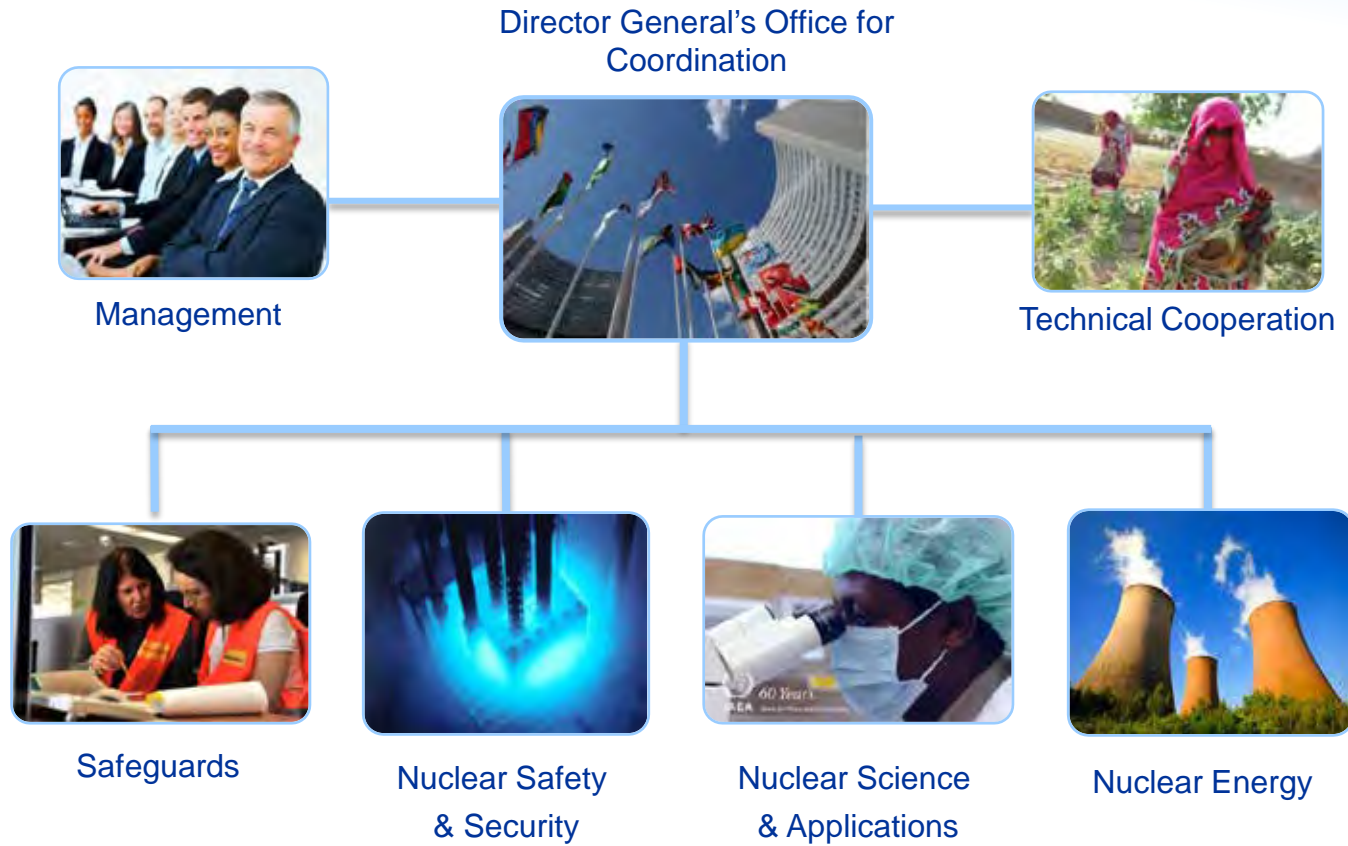

- WTO has no reporting obligation to the GA, but contributes on an ad hoc basis to GA and Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) work on inter alia, trade and development issues.
- Specialized agencies are autonomous organizations whose work is coordinated through ECOSOC (inter-governmental level) and CEB (intra-secretariat level).
- The Trusteehip Council suspended operation on 1 November 1994, as on 1 October 1994 Hq. the last United Nations Trust Territory, became independent.

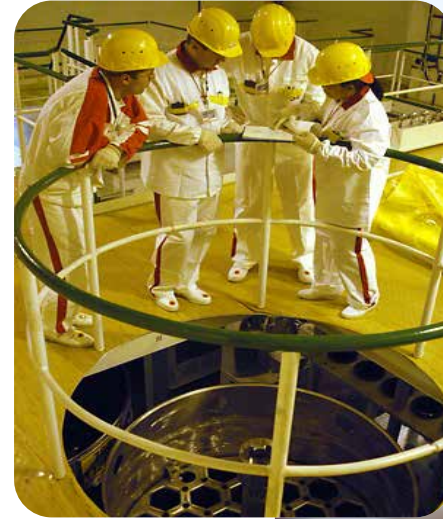

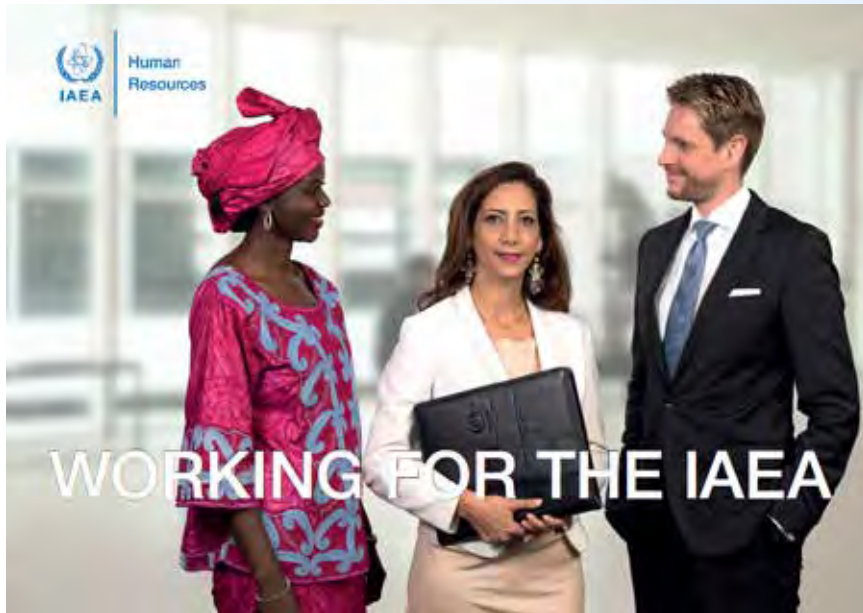

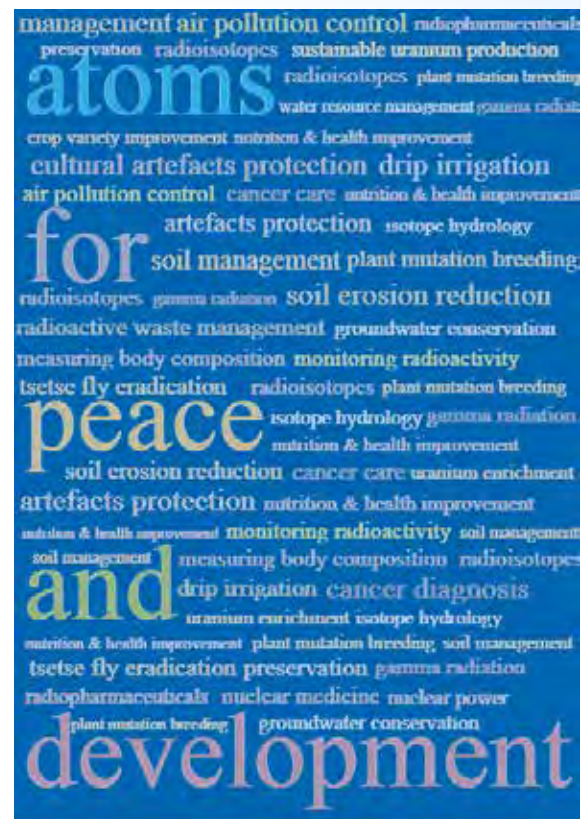

Fellowships & Scientific Visits

- The IAEA Careers Program at Argonne encourages well-qualified Americans to join the IAEA's professional staff in non-Safeguards Departments and assists interested candidates in applying to those positions.
- International Safeguards Project Office at Brookhaven National Laboratory supports well-qualified Americans to join the IAEA's professional staff in Safeguards Departments.
- 11-12% of staff at the IAEA are from the United States.
- IAEA Careers recruits U.S.-sponsored Cost-Free Expert positions, Junior Professional Officer positions and internships in non-Safeguards Departments at the IAEA.

ANL-IP Sponsored Internships

- Internship positions last for one year
- Approximately 6 positions posted per year
- Includes a stipend to cover basic costs



Junior Professional Officer Positions

- The Junior Professional Officer (JPO) program offers US citizens an opportunity to temporarily join the IAEA's workforce in order to gain work experience in an international environment and learn specialized skills they can bring back to the United States
- Assignments generally last 1-2 years, 6-10 positions per year
- Must be under 32 years old to apply and hold a university degree.
- Fluency in English is required. Knowledge of an official Agency language is a plus (Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian and Spanish).



Cost-Free Expert Positions

- Cost-Free Expert are sponsored by the U.S. to provide additional expertise in specific fields in the form of supplemental staff and possess highly specialized skills.
- These positions generally last two years
- At the P-3 to P-5 levels and do not include managerial or supervisory tasks. Open to U.S. candidates
