

Junior Professional Officer (JPO) Application Checklist

The Junior Professional Officer (JPO) program offers young United States professionals an opportunity to join the IAEA's workforce on a temporary, fixed-term basis in order to gain work experience in an international environment and learn specialized skills they can bring back to the US. JPOs work in scientific, technical or administrative fields as part of a team, under the guidance of a senior professional.

[IAEA Programs at Argonne](#) administers the US JPO program for all non-Safeguards IAEA departments. Assignments are typically two years in duration. Based on the IAEA's requirements, individuals are eligible to apply to the JPO program if they are 32 years old or younger and hold a university degree (*note that some positions require an advanced degree*). Eligibility is limited to US citizens unless otherwise indicated on the job description.
