- Evaluate performance of licensed nuclear power reactors to assure the existing security, safeguards, fitness-for-duty and access authorization programs provide the intended level of protection (e.g., as defined in the design basic threat and in NRC regulations).
- Respond to incidents reported by NRC licensees in the security area.
- Follow up on problems to ensure that NRC licensees have taken appropriate corrective action.
