Most Relevant Past Experience:

Prior to his move to Vienna, he was Senior Manager in the Nuclear Funding and Financing Unit within the Ministry of Finance in Ontario, Canada. From 2007 to 2009 he represented the Ministry on the team tasked with conducting the competitive procurement of up to 3,500 MWe of nuclear generating capacity for the Province. During this period he participated in negotiations with AREVA, Westinghouse and AECL, and chaired the Commercial Team during the final evaluation of vendors' bids.

He did his undergraduate degree in economics at the London School of Economics, and graduate work in economics at the Universities of Essex and Warwick.
