#### Scope of Present Duties:

I provide environmental consultancy support to the nuclear, NORM and uranium mining industries especially in the areas of stakeholder engagement, environmental remediation and radioactive waste management. I am currently helping to coordinate the production of an IAEA TECDOC and underpinning training course that guides regulators in their review of environmental remediation plans at uranium mining/milling sites. In the UK, I am supporting a number of organisations on major Framework Programmes covering the assessment of contaminated land, environmental remediation and radioactive waste management.

#### Most Relevant Past Experience:

I have assisted with the formulation and delivery of this decommissioning and environmental remediation training course for the last five years. I am the nominated chair of the Steering Committee of the IAEA's network on environmental management and remediation (ENVIRONET) and supported the IAEA's CIDER project which looks at overcoming the barriers to successful D&D and ER. In October 2013 and again in December 2014, I took part in an IAEA international expert mission to Fukushima which provided an assessment of progress in the environmental remediation of the regions adjacent to the stricken NPP. In October 2014 I was a lead lecturer on an IAEA international training course held in Romania on environmental remediation plans.
